Description:

Botulinum toxins and dermal fillers are the two most popular cosmetic treatments in the UK. - Develop an understanding of licensed guidelines and core techniques to deliver dermal fillers to the mid and lower face for aesthetic use.
- Understand the associated anatomy related to the described toxin and dermal filler indications, as well as the areas of caution.
- Awareness of safe delivery of botulinum toxin and dermal filler interventions to the face.
- Awareness of potential complications and appropriate action plan to reduce risk.
- Live or Applied Demonstration of safe delivery of botulinum toxin and dermal filler to the face.
